

Plumas Pines Men's Club, Inc.
Board Meeting Notes
July 1, 2010

The meeting was held at Longboards at 2:20 pm. Board members present were Curry Jameson, Dave Stone, Randy McDonald, Bill Grijalva, Marv Pierce, Paul Jeglum, and Doyle Blaylock.

President's Report—The Men's/Women's mixer went very well. Due to a mix-up we now have paper supplies for a couple of years.

Last month we asked Brad Miller to give the board an update of the financing of the Portola High School golf team. Here are the results of the discussion. The golf team costs about \$1,800 to \$2,000 a year. About 1/3 of this cost is covered by the Plumas Pines Men's Club. Women's Club donates \$100 to \$200. No funding is provided by the Graeagle or Whitehawk Clubs. No funding is received from the school or Purple Pride Boosters. Additional funding is from local businesses. Purple Pride Booster funding is split 40% sports and 60% academics. This year the Purple Pride Golf tournament was headed up by folks who were not familiar with the history of the event. Next year this should be different and Brad hopes to get more involved.

May Meeting Notes—Approved

Treasurers Report—After a deposit yet to be made, we will have about \$140 less than last year at this time. Two teams have paid for the Mt Classic. See treasurer's report attached to hard copy of these notes.

Membership Report—We have 120 members to date; last year we had 130.

The Women's Club pays \$150 toward the \$1000 scholarship; Curry to ask Jennifer if they can increase their donation to \$500.

Tournament Report—Match play on schedule. Will schedule a Thursday tournament where all golfers will use the combo tees.

Old Business—When we decide to raise the entry fee to the Mt Classic we decided if there was a profit it would go to the auxiliary or PEEHA. Decide the first \$500 should go to PEEHA and the remainder, up to \$500, to the auxiliary.

Next Meeting—Next meeting will be Thursday July 29th, after golf at Longboards.
