Fall Meeting Notes—Approved

Treasurers Report—We have \$9,584 in the bank. Last year at this time we had \$10,148. When accounting for payments made this year versus last year we are within \$100 of last year balance. See treasurer's report attached to hard copy of these notes.

Membership Report—53 members to date, six are new to the club. This is a little ahead of the numbers we had last year.

Handicap Report—Handicaps (GHIN) will be updated two times per month next season.

Tournament Report—Discussed changing the individual trophies for the major events to perpetual trophies; decided to put the issue to the membership at the spring meeting.

Appears we need more space at the pro shop for plaques because the name places are filled up; Curry to discuss with Brandon.

Discussed mixing up foursomes every other week. This could be random or ABCD draws. Try for random draws when there are individual events. Need to factor in NCGA qualifiers and match play.

For reverse shotguns, place three foursomes on the first tee so there is not a gap before the first group from 18 gets there.

The deadline for signup for Thursday events is noon Wednesday. After the deadline the individual is on a standby basis; every effort will be made to get late signups in but no guaranties. This needs to be included in the 2010 booklet.

Curry to work with Sean on drinks and food after each Thursday golf tournament.

Mountain Classic—Course reserved for 9/10-11/2010. Need to wait until Plumas Pines do their budget for next year, this should be in December, and then we can budget the tournament. Green fee should be the same (\$45/\$55). The practice round should be \$45. The letters to the tee sponsors and raffle donors have been revised.

Doyle plans to be chair for two years. Larry will be an advisor for this year. Will need an assistant for next year, who in turn will become the chair the following year.
