May 6, 2010

Curry J. opened the meeting at 3:00 pm. There were about 20 +/- members present. He encouraged the members to sign-up for match play. For men's Thursdays, after play, drinks and food at Longboards will be 20% off.

Dave S. handed out the 2010 local rules and emphasized the use of distance measuring devices. He also encouraged members to review the revised men's club web site.

Randy Mac. stated the account balances but the Secretary did not catch the amounts. Suffice it to say the club is in good financial shape (see board meeting notes). The club gave \$50 to Horses Unlimited, \$650 to Portola High School golf team, and \$500 to scholarship recipient (2nd recipient never claimed their scholarship).

Bill G. reported we have 114 members to date and one more planning to join. 14 of our members are also members of NNGA. Manny Madina passed away on 4/27.

Paul J. handed out the 2010 handicap policy. GHIN is now updating two times per month so timely postings is a must. The handicap committee will audit posted rounds at the end of each month. If there are issues with any round it will be communicated to the golfer. Should there be more than two communications to the same golfer a penalty handicap may be imposed.

Marv P. is developing a combination tee (red and white) that might be used by senior members. Marv will present to the board at their next meeting.

Brandon B. thought the combination tee will help Mark out. The gold tee markers will be put out every Thursday for now. If the combination tees are approved, the posting computer should be able to be modified to allow posting. The Pro/Am is now called the Mohawk Valley Pro/Am; it will be played at Plumas Pines 5/23 and Whitehawk 5/24 and is limited to 24 teams. The ownership discussed a walking rate for public and members; not for this year but possible for 2011. The sign-up binder for men's events is at the first counter, on the right, as you walk into the pro shop. If you are interested in night golf let Brandon know. The pre-school tournament has been postponed to an unknown date.

Roger N. asked the members when they sign-up to not use just their first name and to indicate which tee they will be using.

Doyle B. reviewed the Mt. Classic; it will be 9/10 and 11. The format and all other aspects will be virtually the same as last year. Deadline for sign-up is 8/28. Tee sponsor letters are out and raffle donor letters should be out soon.

Curry J., before closing the meeting, received feedback on a perpetual trophy, instead of individual plaques, for the various winners; the board will make the decision on this. Meeting closed at 3:55 pm.
